From here on, in this document, the Leicestershire & Rutland Family History Society will be known as the LRFHS.

By using this Website and agreeing to this Cookies Policy, you are consenting to the LRFHS's use of cookies in accordance with the terms of this Cookies Policy.

1. DEFINITIONS

1. In this Cookies Policy the definitions set out in the Terms of Website Use will apply (except where the context otherwise requires).

2. COOKIES AND HOW WE USE THEM

1. Cookies are small 'packets' of data downloaded to your computer which communicate with websites in order to provide information to those who operate them. For example, they may help website operators improve your experience on their website or to distinguish you from other users.
2. Facebook Cookies "dpr" & "fr" are used by a third-party widget provided by Facebook on our index page. The LRFHS have no control over its use and cannot influence the use or data it uses. Cookies are deleted when you leave the website.

3. PayPal Cookies “01AI (abmr.net)” & “PYPF”. PayPal uses Cookies to recognise its customers and to shorten the time the user needs to log in to his PayPal account . They also are used by PayPal to monitor transactions and website usage. This data is not personal to the user to purely to the website at the LRFHS. They are provided by PayPal and the LRFHS have no control over its use. Cookie “01AI (abmr.net)” is deleted when you leave the website. Cookie ABMR.NET is valid for a year. Both cookies carry no user data.

All cookies can be blocked in the settings for the browser being used if you so wish.

This is a decision that the user makes and applies at the users discretion.

If they are blocked, then certain functionality may be lost.

In this case PayPal purchases may not work, and Facebook pages may not be displayed.
